- 1. PERFORM A TRADEMARK SEARCH
 BEFORE CHOOSING A NAME OR LOGO
 - This is more than just searching the Division of Corporations or the USPTO
 - b. Finding out that your name/logo infringes a trademark after you launch means you'll probably have to rebrand, which is expensive and time-consuming!
 - 2. CONSULT WITH YOU ACCOUNTANT REGARDING THE BEST ENTITY TYPE FOR YOUR TAX SITUATION
 - Some entities have options for how they are taxed, others do not.
 This is not a one-size-fits-all situation.



- 3. DETERMINE WHO YOUR REGISTERED AGENT WILL BE
 - a. This person must be available at the address listed during regular business hours.
- 4. HAVE YOUR ENTITY DOCUMENTS DRAFTED (OPERATING AGREEMENT, BYLAWS, MINUTES, ETC.)
 THEN FILE WITH THE STATE TO FORM YOUR LLC OR CORPORATION
- 5. GET YOUR TAX ID NUMBER (EIN)
 FROM THE IRS





6. OPEN A BUSINESS BANK ACCOUNT

- a. Make sure you don't commingle personal and business funds! That could cause big problems later on.
- 7. FILE TRADEMARK REGISTRATIONS
 FOR YOUR NAME AND LOGO
- 8. ENSURE THAT YOUR BENEFICIAL OWNER REPORT IS FILED ON TIME AND PROPERLY.
 - a. There are hefty fines for failing to do so!





- OBTAIN REQUIRED LICENSES
 AND PERMITS, SUCH AS A
 BUSINESS LICENSE FROM
 YOUR TOWN, CITY,
 AND/OR COUNTY
- TALK TO YOUR INSURANCE
 AGENT ABOUT WHICH POLICIES
 ARE REQUIRED AND WHICH
 ARE OPTIONAL BUT ADVISABLE
 - For example, you may be required to carry Worker's Comp, but General Liability may be wise as well!
